

The 2018 Becca Weissbard Award

The junior committee has created the Becca Weissbard Award in remembrance of Rebecca Weissbard. All Long Island riders are encouraged to apply. The recipient(s) will receive:

- A \$150 grant for lessons, clinics, or show fees of the recipient's choice with a trainer in good standing of the LIPHA. The grant must be used in 2018.

Requirements

- 1) Applicants should write a one page essay answering the following: ***“What is your favorite thing about your horse?”***
- 2) Applicants must submit one letter of recommendation from a trainer, barn manager, barn owner, etc. The letter should include relationship with applicant and detail his/her strengths in academics, community service, horses, and horsemanship.
- 3) Applicants must attend a minimum of one Junior meeting at the Paradise Diner in Hauppauge, NY (held on the first Monday of every month) before the due date to be eligible.
- 4) Completed application must be signed by the applicant and a parent/guardian.

The completed application must be received by email or in person on or by May 5th, 2018 in order for recipients to be chosen by the panel of judges by the annual LIPHA Horse Show. Recipients will be presented their awards at the horse show in May (date to follow).
